**Notice of Race**

**1. RULES**

The Regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing*, except as altered by the Sailing Instructions.

**2. ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY**

Each club in the Eastern Division of the NSA may enter one boat in the event. Both skipper and crew must not turn 19 years old in the year of the event and must be current members of US Sailing. You must notify the Northeast Harbor Sailing School (207.276.5101) by Monday, July 5<sup>th</sup> if you are planning on attending the event.

**3. BOATS**

The Northeast Harbor Sailing School will supply Club 420s with trap and spinnaker. Teams are to bring their own spinnaker pole and PFDs.

**4. SAFETY**

A US Coast Guard approved personal flotation device shall be worn, properly fastened, at all times while launching and when sailing. Failure to comply with this rule may result in disqualification as deemed appropriate by the protest committee. Please bring the *Eastern Bemis Medical Form* for both skipper and crew with you to the event.

**5. SCHEDULE OF RACES**

Please report to the Northeast Harbor Fleet at 1130 on Thursday, July 8th. A competitor's meeting will be held as soon as everyone arrives. If you are late or lost, please call (207) 276-5101 or (202) 215-5966. There will be as many races as possible, but no race will be started after 1600. Three races must be completed for the series.

**6. PRIZES**

The first and second place finishers will qualify to compete in the NSA Junior Double-handed Championship at Southport Yacht Club on Friday, July 23<sup>rd</sup>. Qualifying teams shall make a decision to compete no later than 1700 on July 9, 2010. If no decision is made, the qualifying spots will be offered to the next highest competition.
